Recommended Yarn

SIZE

Approx. 60 x 50 cm

MATERIALS

Schachenmayr Lenja Soft 25 g ball

Approx. 25 g ≈ 85 m

Fb 01090 (grau) 5 balls

Yarn amounts are approximate. Make sure to purchase enough of the same dye lot in order to complete your project. The amount of yarn needed can vary from person to person.

1 circular needle size 2.5 mm (US size 1), 80 cm long

500 g filling material

1 tapestry needle for weaving in ends

GAUGE

Stockinette stitch and reverse stockinette stitch (knit tightly):

20 st and 30 R = 10 x 10 cm

If your gauge differs from the given gauge, use needles of a larger or smaller size accordingly.

NOTE:

The pillow should be knitted tightly so that there are no holes through which the filling material can be seen.

THE BAISCS

Stockinette stitch: RS: knit all st; WS: purl all st.

Reverse Stockinette stitch: RS: purl all st; WS: knit all st.

Increases:

Increases are worked at the end of the row by looping or knitting on sts.

Decreases:

Decreases are worked at the beginning of the row by fasten off sts.

INSTRUCTIONS

The pillow is knitted crosswise, as this makes it easier to work the increases and decreases for the curves of the cloud. Work according to the chart 1 front piece and 1 back piece, working one piece in stockinette stitch and 1 piece in reverse stockinette stitch.

Cast on 20 st and work 1 WS row.

Work the increases and decreases according to the chart.

FINISHING

Dampen and block the pieces according the measurements; allow to dry.

Place the two sides right sides together and sew together with thin matching yarn along all sides, do not join approx. 10 cm. Turn the pillow.

Stuff the pillow and sew up the final side.

KEY

A = cast on

z = increase at the end of the row

a = decrease at the beginning of the row

ABBREVIATIONS

R = row(s)

RS = right side

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side
