KNOTS USED:

Lark's head knot

Square knot

(see at the end step by step tutorials for these knots)

BEFORE STARTING

Cut the following:

- 4x 300 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 290 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 280 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 270 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 260 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 250 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 240 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 230 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 220 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 210 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 200 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 190 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 180 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 2x 170 cm ropes in colour 00106
- 14x 170 cm ropes in colour 00106

STEP BY STEP

STEP 1: Hang the wooden ring on the chariot. Fold in half the 4 ropes of 300 cm each into the wooden ring (150 cm each side) and make lark's head knots.



STEP 3: Make another square knot but using the 4 central cords so we have a "triangle".

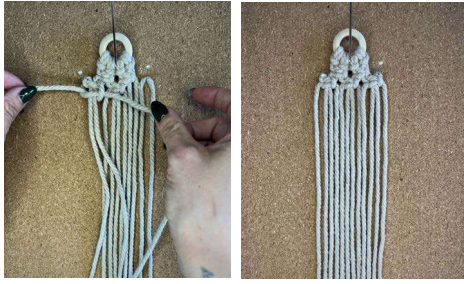


STEP 2: Make a square knot on the first 4 cords and make another one on the next 4 cords.



STEP 4: Add the two 290 cm ropes by folding them in half and pin them to the cork base in each side of the piece as per image bellow. Make a square knot on each side to secure the new added ropes.





STEP 5: Add two 280 cm ropes on the sides and repeat step 4. To complete the row make 2 more square knots using the middle cords. We have now 4 rows.



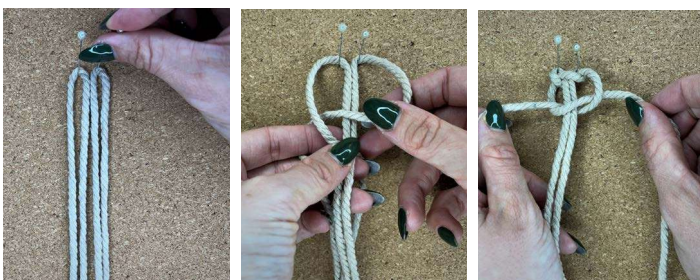
STEP 6: For the next rows continue to add 2 ropes on each side always with 10 cm less than the previous one added. Complete each row by making square knots in the cords left in the middle. In total we should have at the end 14 rows. (use hanger support)



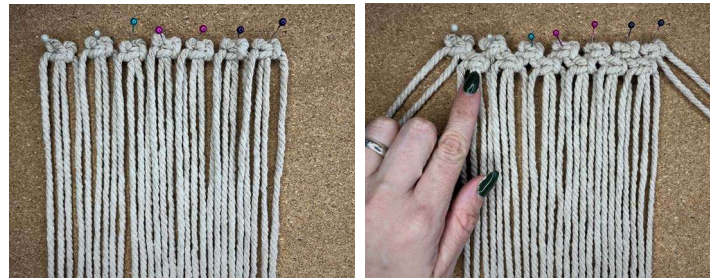
STEP 7: Bend both sides (2 double knots for each side) to find out how many rows we need to make our piece completely closed. We can see that a total of 7 rows are missing. (7/8/9/10).



STEP 8: Start making the second part of the pocket by folding in half 2 of the 170 cm ropes and pin them side by side in the cork base and make a square knot.



STEP 9: repeat step 8, six more times till you have a row of 7 square knots. On the second row, starting from the left leave the first to cords free and make squares knot till the end of the row, there should be six knots in total.

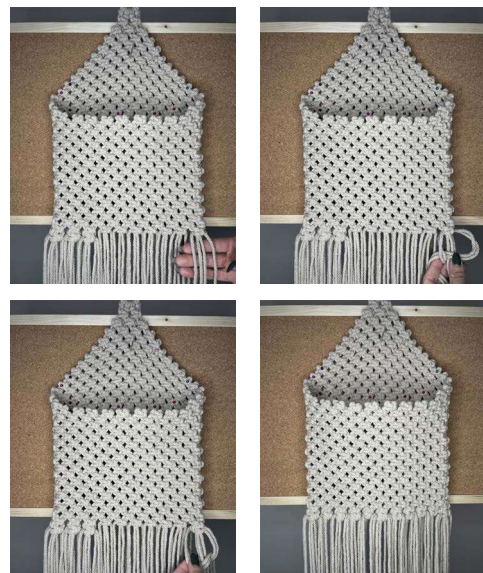


STEP 10: Join this new piece with the triangle piece placing it in the middle, using pins to hold them into the new structure. Using 2 cords from the "triangle" and 2 cords from the new piece make a square knot to secure them together. Continue doing square knots to the right, going around the piece till the 1st square knot of this step. You have now 3 rows.



STEP 11: Make 16 more rows of square knots till you have in total 19 rows.

STEP 12: Close the bottom of the pocket by making square knots using both front and back cords. Do this till the bottom of the pocket is completely closed.



STEP 13: Measure 15 cm and cut the edges and open the cords so they look like fluffy fringes.



SQUARE KNOT – SQUARE KNOT BAND

Step 1: The 4 filler and working strands are arranged parallel, the working strands A and D are on the outside and the filler strands B/C are in the middle.

Step 2: Place D from right to left over B/C and under A.

Step 3: Bring A from left to right under B/C.

Step 4: Pull A from the back to the front through the loop created by D.

Step 5: Carefully pull A and D tightly.

The first basic knot is finished = 1 half square knot.

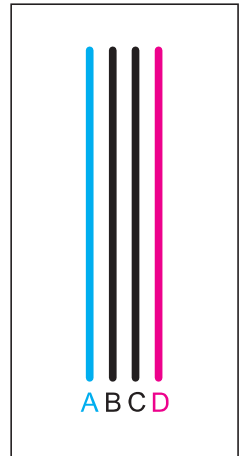
Step 6: Place D from left to right over B/C and under A.

Step 7: Bring A from right to left under B/C.

Pull A from the back to the front through the loop created by D.

Carefully pull A and D tightly.

The second basic knot is finished = 1 square knot.

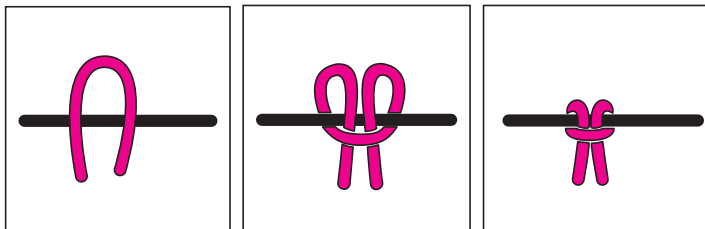
MACRAMÉ KNOTS TUTORIALS STEP BY STEP

LARK'S HEAD KNOT

Step 1: Fold one strand (consisting of a filler strand and a working strand) in half and place the loop on top of a cord, a rod or a ring.

Step 2: Fold the loop down the back

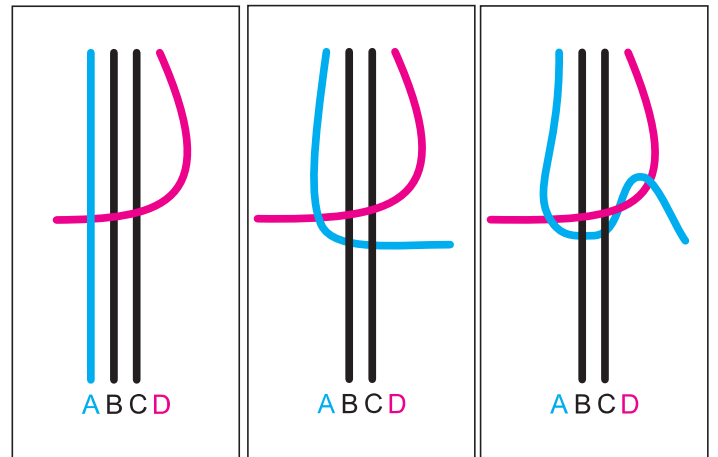
Step 3: Pull the ends of the strand through the loop and pull tightly.

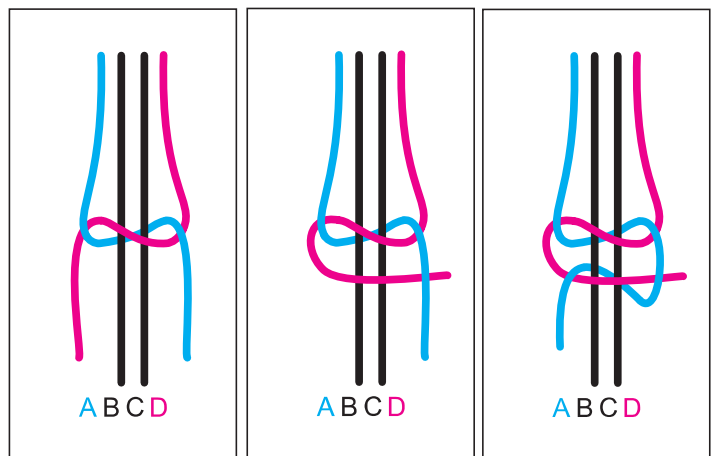

Note: Due to the fact, that Crafty Fine yarn is recycled from colour-assorted textile material and not re-dyed there can be slight variations in color and thickness. We therefore recommend buying enough yarn for your project. We also advise to use a crochet needle without handle, which is easier to work with. The first stitches might be a little bit hard to work, but you will soon get used, and the final result is worth it.

WASHING ADVICE

Always wash in as warm a water temperature as possible - up to the temperature recommended, with a short spin. Use a lot of water if hand washing. For darker colours we recommend the use of discolouration sheets. Do not bleach.

Do not tumble dry. Drip-dry on a horizontal surface.

Iron on a hot temperature setting using a damp cloth.
